

Venezuela Earthquake Prayer Guide



Pray for Venezuela

Two powerful earthquakes struck Venezuela's north-central coast on June 24, causing widespread damage in and around the capital, Caracas. Families fled into the streets as buildings collapsed. Rescue teams continue searching through the rubble, and aftershock are still being felt.

In moments like this, the local church is not far away.

The Venezuelan Baptist Convention has called its churches to serve as places of refuge and hope for their communities. Even as they assess damage and care for their own families, pastors and church members are already responding to the needs around them.

As you pray, ask God to strengthen His Church in Venezuela and draw many people to the hope found in Jesus Christ.

Pray for Families

Pray for those who have been injured, for families grieving loss, and for those whose homes have been damaged or destroyed. Ask God to provide comfort, protection, and daily provision as communities begin the difficult work of recovery.

Pray for Rescue and Relief

Pray for rescue workers searching through damaged buildings and for wisdom as leaders assess needs and coordinate relief efforts. Ask God to protect everyone serving in dangerous conditions as aftershocks continue.

Pray for Local Churches

Pray for pastors and churches across Venezuela as they open their doors to care for neighbors. Ask God to give them strength, wisdom, and compassion as they provide practical help and point people to the hope of Christ.

Pray for Gospel Hope

In a time of crisis, many people begin asking deeper questions about life and hope. Pray that God would use the faithful presence of local churches to draw people to Himself and that many would hear and respond to the good news of Jesus.
