





In a remote village in Uganda, the people rely on their cows to plow fields for crops that will last them the whole year.

## PIG


Ellen is a caring mother to several young children in Kenya.

## **GOAT**


One community of farmers in the Philippines was having a hard time keeping food on the table for their families.
